Amendment C1: Amend to Canon 10 to Allow for Missions of Virginia Theological Seminary

Are there historical examples of missions founded by VTS?

Virginia Theological Seminary supported a series of missions from before the Civil War through 1952. The diocesan journals listed them as “Missions under the Virginia Theological Seminary.” Seven such mission were listed in the 1941 Journal: Immanuel Chapel, Theological Seminary; St. John's Chapel, Glencarlyn; St. John's Chapel, West End; Christ Chapel, Groveton (St. Mark's Alexandria); St. Paul's Chapel, Baileys Cross Roads; All Saints Chapel, Sharon; and St. Luke's Chapel, Wellington Villa. The last listing was in 1952 and included three congregations: St. John's Chapel, Glencarlyn; Christ Chapel, Groveton (St. Mark's Alexandria); and All Saints Chapel, Sharon. In the early years, the professor of Pastoral Theology took responsibility for oversight of the missions; by the 1940s, the dean began to play a more active role in leadership. Students provided much of the pastoral and liturgical leadership.
