**Life Line Screening:** January 30 in Patience Hall. St. Mark's is pleased to host an affordable preventive health event.. It is non-invasive and painless. There are five screenings that scan for potential health problems related to blocked arteries, abdominal aortic aneurysms, hardening of the arteries, atrial fibrillation or irregular heart beat and a bone density screening. All five screenings take 60-90 minutes and cost \$149.
