

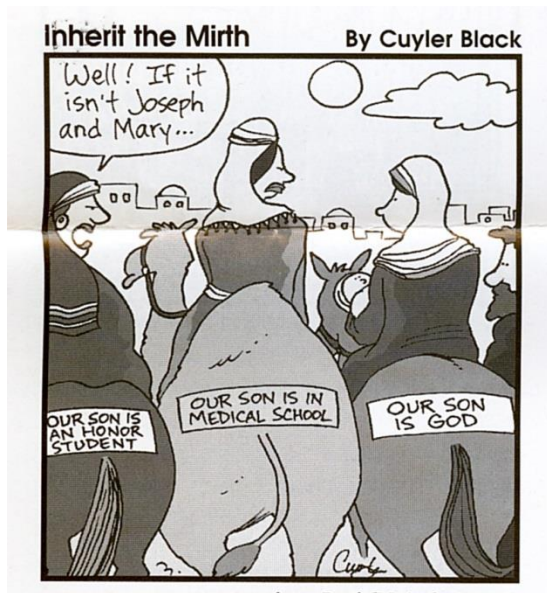
Spread, O Spread, Thou Mighty Word
