Lord, You Give Us The Great Commission

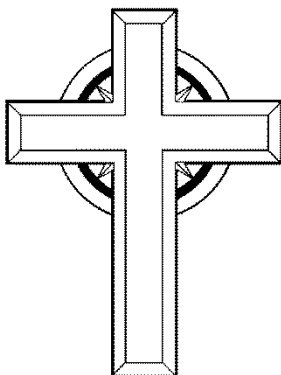
