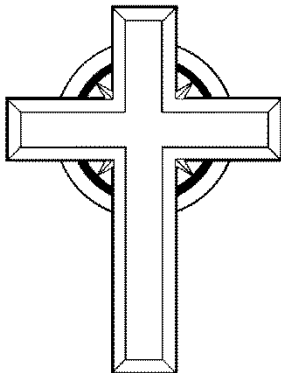
Singing Songs of Expectation
