From the Rector’s Desk

Mercifully, every year we are brought back to Easter, and the story begins again. But this time, we apply it differently to our lives because we are different. And we keep moving, because on this side of the grave, that is what life is all about. We keep moving, even when we are standing still. And each time we come back to the Resurrection, we may experience his grace again in our lives and deepen our awareness of how God has provided for us.

Why does the Resurrection conclude with the women running away, afraid to tell anyone about what has happened? I think the answer is really simple...It’s because the Gospel isn’t finished. It’s up to you and me to complete the story. The resurrection is a story about movement:. The women are moving. Jesus is moving. If we won’t – who will? The resurrection is not the end of the story. The end has yet to be written, and we need to finish it. And so we don’t shout “Alleluia” because the story has ended. We shout “Alleluia” because the story continues and you and I are with God as the new Gospel writers. Almighty God, grant us, frail beings that we are, to move toward our future, and bring with it such a sure confidence in your love that we will lose our fears, and live in the knowledge of your presence, from which neither life nor death or fear can separate us.
